MISSION

GOALS

The goals of the Laurenti Mohochi Educational foundation include the following:

1. To raise funds to implement the mission of the foundation.
2. To build model schools that provide affordable and quality education that gives children in marginalized communities (e.g. Kuria) a fighting chance in the stiff competition for space in Kenya's institutions of higher education.
3. To offer scholarships that would enable bright young boys and girls from poor families to acquire an education, hence giving them an opportunity to partake of a basic human right, and uplift themselves as well as their families from abject poverty.
4. To offer the youth in poor communities (e.g. Kuria district) an opportunity to participate in community service through an outreach program that also offers guidance, career, and health education in light of the HIV/AIDS prevalence in the region.
